Financial Commitment

Tuition and other fees are to be paid in advance. Students dropping out of school for the month of June for any reason are still responsible for paying tuition for June. Tuition is due on the first day of the month and becomes delinquent the 6th day of the month. Accounts overdue will result in students not being permitted to attend classes until the account is paid. A late charge of \$1.00 per day will be added to accounts not paid by the 6th. Accounts overdue by two months will incur a \$2.00 per day charge. Please mail payments due during Christmas and Easter holidays. Returned checks will be charged \$35.00 and cash only will be accepted on future accounts. Fees for milk and extended childcare should be paid with the monthly tuition. Tuition will not fluctuate for holidays or student absenteeism. Report cards are not issued if the student's account is not paid in full. The last report card will be mailed upon receipt of postage for a first class letter. Assessments will be made to cover damaged property and/or other students' possessions.
